

TICKETS PURCHASED PRIOR TO JANUARY 2010 NO LONGER ACCEPTED ON GCT BUSES

In January 2010, Gold Coast Transit raised transit fares and offered a six-month grace period for tickets and passes purchased at the old fare rates to be used or exchanged. Effective July 1, 2010, Gold Coast Transit will no longer accept as payment the following Gold Coast Transit tickets and passes purchased prior to the fare increase:

If you have purchased your tickets from an authorized ticket outlet since January 24, 2010 and the face value is more than the rates mentioned above, your ticket is still valid for use.

If you have any of the old passes mentioned above, you may exchange them for credit towards a new ticket. Refunds will not be issued and you will have to pay the difference between the fare rate on your ticket and the new fare rates. Tickets may be exchanged only at:
